The requirement

Walsingham College Trust Association Ltd's initial requirement was for a brand new centrally managed IT infrastructure for its 75 staff, guests and visitors. This later extended to wireless internet access across their geographically and structurally diverse site, which includes medieval buildings, a new refectory and retail shop.

The solution

We first began working with Walsingham College Trust Association Ltd over a decade ago and installed a completely new IT infrastructure including a traditional cabled network.



Since then, we have added a wireless network solution across their site and recently updated their core infrastructure by replacing their end-of-life servers with new hardware and software.
